**SCOTT MEDLOCK LAUNCHES "REFLECTION"**  
**FOR COLLECTORS WORLDWIDE**

***Jack Nicklaus, The PGA TOUR & Pebble Beach Team with Medlock To  
Create Limited Edition Canvases of "The Golden Bear"***

MOORPARK, Calif. – In conjunction with The Nicklaus Companies, the PGA TOUR and Pebble Beach Resorts, acclaimed artist and Southern California native Scott Medlock recently announced the launch of his latest portrait oil painting "Reflection." The 18" x 24" limited edition work features golf's all-time major championship winner **Jack Nicklaus** sitting on the fence adjacent to Pebble Beach's 18<sup>th</sup> tee box at the 2000 U.S. Open, likely his last appearance in our national championship.

Each of the 500 limited-edition canvases sell for \$1,800 and comes accompanied by a Certificate of Authenticity, holograms, authorized signatures by Nicklaus and Medlock, and a photograph of Nicklaus and Medlock signing the work. Each of the 150 hand-embellished editions, featuring original highlights on each canvas and also signed and numbered by Medlock and Nicklaus, sell for \$2,500.

Recently, Medlock signed a licensing agreement with the PGA TOUR making "Reflection" an official artwork of the TOUR.

**Scott Medlock Fine Arts Launches *Reflection***

Medlock, born in Glendale, Calif., in 1968, has, in a remarkably short period of time, risen to the top of the contemporary art world. While having painted a variety of subjects from many walks of life, his fine art reproductions of golf and sports legends remain peerless for their dramatic blend of precision and passion. Medlock's mesmerizing attention to detail is matched only by his tremendous understanding of athletic movement itself, a kind of insight that frees the essence of well-known athletes in motion and lets them live forever within the frames of his work. Renowned for its impeccable craftsmanship and subtle touches of imagination, Medlock's art invites viewers to enter into the heart of athletic competition, a place where the nobility of sportsmanship meets the tireless pursuit of perfection.

"I want to capture a moment in time," Medlock says, "but I equally want to keep an element of mystery in the work so that viewers use their own imagination to complete it."

Among Medlock's many award-winning achievements, several in particular stand out: Davis Love III with arms raised after sinking the crucial putt to win the 1993 Ryder Cup for the United States; In 1995, the family of Babe Ruth commissioned Medlock to create a work commemorating the Babe's historical farewell address to his fans in Yankee Stadium; His tribute to Ben Hogan, 'Legends of Golf', is the first work of its kind to capture Jack Nicklaus and Arnold Palmer together. Nicklaus and Palmer are pictured walking down a fairway at famed Riviera CC with a silhouetted image of Hogan hovering above the clubhouse in the background. This piece was used as an official poster and artwork of the 1998 U.S. Senior Open.
